PLANNING PANEL APPOINTED TO CONSIDER SUBMISSIONS

WestWind Energy lodged a Planning Permit Application (PPA) with the Minister for Planning for the Lal Lal Wind Farm in March 2008. The application and reports were then publicly exhibited up until early August 2008. Now that the exhibition period is complete and submissions have been received, the Minister for Planning has appointed a Planning Panel to consider our planning permit application and provide him with recommendations before he makes a determination of our application.

The role of the panel is to:

- ▲ Give submitters an opportunity to be heard by an independent forum.
- ▲ Give independent advice to the Minister about the planning permit application.

The Hearing process is in two stages and will follow a clear and structured format, beginning with a Directions Hearing followed by the Main Hearing.

The Hearings are open to the public but to be heard by the Panel you must have made a submission to the Minister for Planning and completed a 'request to be heard' application.

The Directions Hearing will be held on Monday 22nd September, 2008 commencing at 11am at

Wendouree Parade, Lake Wendouree.

DIRECTIONS HEARING

The purpose of the Directions Hearing will be to:

- ▲ Introduce the Panel;
- ▲ Consider any matters of a preliminary nature;
- ▲ Identify any changes proposed to the exhibited Application;
- ▲ Clarify the issues that are in contention;
- ▲ Consider timetable issues;
- ▲ Give directions about the conduct of the hearing;
- ▲ Give directions about the exchange of information before the hearing;
- ▲ Answer any questions people may have about the nature of the hearing;
- ▲ Deal with any other procedural or relevant matters; and
- ▲ Make arrangements for the hearing, including the hearing venue and site inspections.

MAIN HEARING

The Main Hearing gives people an opportunity to be heard in support of their submission. This hearing will commence from Wednesday 5th November, 2008 at "Sails on the Lake".

The Main Hearing may run for several days or weeks depending on the amount of time requested by parties to the hearing. The schedule will be confirmed at the Directions Hearing.

The general order of the Main Hearing is likely to be:

- ▲ Department of Planning and Community Development on behalf of the Minister for Planning;
- ▲ The Proponent (WestWind Energy)
- ▲ Other Government Departments/Agencies
- ▲ Councils
- ▲ Community Groups
- ▲ Individual submitters

COMPLEX CULTURAL HERITAGE MANAGEMENT PLAN

Since lodging our planning permit application report in March 2008, the sub-surface testing of the Site for items of aboriginal cultural heritage significance has been completed. As a result of the findings of this work some wind turbines and access tracks have had to be moved slightly (by between 20m and 100m) so that we can avoid some artefact scatters as much as possible.

A "Complex Cultural Heritage Management Plan", which builds on the original "Standard Cultural Heritage Management Plan", has now been lodged with Aboriginal Affairs Victoria.

Aboriginal Affairs Victoria is currently reviewing our new draft of the plan to ensure it complies with the Cultural Heritage Act. They will need to endorse the plan before any determination can be made under the Planning and Environment Act on the Planning Permit Application itself.

It is expected that the complex Cultural Heritage Management Plan will be endorsed prior to commencement of the Main Hearings in November 2008. Once it comes into effect it will govern our management of aboriginal cultural heritage throughout the life of the project.
